2. We accept a variety of theoretical and practical papers relevant to debate and argumentation education.
3. Submission will be reviewed and acceptance will be notified by Thursday, February 25th.

4. Papers should not have been previously published, except for special cases (Ask the committee about this).

5. Presentations will be 20 minutes and Q&A will be 10 minutes.
